Details of the Decision

The Cabinet Member was delegated to approve for publication the following decision:

Approval to permanently expand Lakeside Primary School (Cheltenham) from its current two form entry to a three form entry primary school from 1 September 2015.

Following the representation period for this decision, and having fully considered all of the available information, the Cabinet Member rejected the alternative options, and resolved to take the recommended decision to: -

To approve the permanent expansion of Lakeside Primary School from its current two forms of entry to three forms of entry, starting in September 2015.

In coming to this decision, the Cabinet Member gave due and full regard to the requirements of the public sector equality duty contained in Section 149 of the Equality Act 2010 ("the Act") by reference to the law itself, and also to the relevant Due Regard Statement, which was prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Act.

To call in this decision, at least five members of the council must submit their request in writing, (including the reasons for the request), to the Chief Executive of Gloucestershire County Council before the end of the fifth working day after the day on which the decision was published.

All requests must be submitted to Jo Moore, (DSU) by 5 pm on Friday 6 June 2014

If no call in is made, the decision will be implemented on Monday 9 June 2014
