

Service update – Stroud

General Overview

The new collection system is operating extremely well and is delivering the desired key outcomes ie, increased recycling, high capture of food waste and low levels of landfill waste. The service, now in its 11th month is estimated to reach a reduced landfill rate of 114 Kgs per head of population.

The council has recently discontinued its 'Bring' bank service, used for the collection of the recycling materials already collected at the kerbside; the change was implemented mainly to remove the duplication of service costs and reduce levels of material contamination. Residents will however be able to continue to recycle other materials such as textiles, Books, CDs etc at these sites.
