


KEY DECISION not published in the Forward Plan	
<p>The following key decision will be considered by the Cabinet at its meeting on 10 October 2018; because the decision is urgent and it has not been possible to publish details about this key decision in the Forward Plan.</p> <p>That Cabinet:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Authorises the Head of the Joint Waste Management to conduct a consultation exercise with the District, Borough and City Councils within Gloucestershire as to the: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) adoption of the NAWDO model as the financial mechanism for the calculation of Tipping Away payments under s52(10) Environmental Protection Act 1990 (EPA); (b) operational issues and any other relevant considerations which should be taken into account in the development of a Tipping Away Policy. 2. Requires the Head of the Joint Waste Management to report back to Cabinet with the results of and recommendations arising from the consultation authorised under Recommendation 1. 	
<p><u>Reason for invoking general exception procedures</u></p> <p>To ensure sufficient time for meaningful consultation with district councils in order to develop an appropriate Waste Tipping Away policy to inform future delivery arrangements and to align with the council's annual budget setting process.</p>
