<p>Reasons for invoking special urgency procedures <i>(as set out in the Council's Constitution, Rules on Access to Information About the County Council's Formal Business paragraphs 18-19 and Call-In Procedure Rules, section 10)</i></p> <p>The Infection Control Fund has been allocated to Gloucestershire from central Government with a mandate to pass the funds on to providers in 20 working days. The funds were received on the 1st October. Since the funding is £6,621,410 an urgent decision is required to ensure appropriate governance and oversight of the spend.</p> <p>As this decision is urgent, it has not been possible to give the required 28 days notice of this key decision.</p>
