

## **Cabinet 5<sup>th</sup> April 2012: Addendum**

An omission was made in the Libraries Equality & Community Impact Assessment and this was not picked up on proof reading.

The details are below:

On page 188 of the Cabinet papers the following information should be inserted after the first paragraph under the heading of 'children':

Berkley:169, with 36% of these showing postcodes from outside the Berkeley

Bream:92, with 16% of these showing postcodes from outside the Bream

Brockworth:594, with 40% showing postcodes from outside the Brockworth

Lechlade: 262, with 23% showing postcodes from outside the Lechlade

Minchinhampton: 559, with 67% showing postcodes from outside Minchinhampton

Mitcheldean:459, with 57% showing postcodes from outside Mitcheldean

Newnham:101,with 40% showing postcodes from outside the Newnham.

At Bream, Brockworth, Minchinhampton and Lechlade class visits are made by local schools and playgroups. As indicated in the Context & User Needs Assessment children's book issues are a higher proportion of all issues at Bream (58.6%) Brockworth (44.3%), and Minchinhampton(47.5%) libraries especially which probably relates to the proximity of schools to the libraries. Bream community have indicated that they would continue the school visits should they set up a community library. At Mitcheldean, the co-located children's centre supports playgroup and nursery visits. The children's centre have indicated that they wish to continue their use of the library should it become a community library.
