Community Infrastructure – key areas

- **HDM** - Enabling new housing and business developments that are accessible to all and delivers sustainable economic growth
- **ITU** - Managing public, community, education transport and bus passes to enable access to work, education and key services. ThinkTravel (Active Travel, Bikeability, School Travel, e-scooters) and GCC Fleet Management.
- **Highway Network Management** – On street Parking, Road Safety, Streetworks, Traffic Signals and Highway Records
- **Climate Change & Air Quality** – delivering a rolling Action Plan to reduce CO2 emissions to Net Zero; investing in EV chargers, renewable energy, tree planting and improving air quality
- **Gypsy & Travellers:** managing GCC's 4 sites and multi agency coordination to tackle unauthorised camps on GCC land.



Key issues and service drivers

Transport infrastructure and services that enable us make healthier, safer and more sustainable sustainable choices:

- Covid-19 Recovery and Growth – HDM improvement plan, Bus Service Improvement Plan, Local Plans
- Climate Change challenge: growing capacity, collaboration, Net Zero pathway, Electric Vehicles, renewables, adaptation
- ITU: public transport recovery, better rural transport options, Arle Court Transport Hub, GCC Fleet Management, E-scooter trials, School streets pilots, RTPI and bus infrastructure
- Network Management: Ageing signals, Parking reviews and technology, Traffic Orders and Road Safety priorities
- Gypsy & Traveller: accommodation, health and skills
- Active travel: focus on quality, skills gaps, internal capacity
