<p>Reason for invoking general exception procedures (as set out in the Council's Constitution, Rules on Access to Information Procedure Rules)</p> <p>The unanticipated continuation of high demand into the summer, along with the continuing pressure on availability of resources and the need to address this before the winter months means that it is necessary to act quickly to ensure there is additional investment in place to ensure appropriate resources are available to fix safety defects and comply with the Council's statutory duty.</p>
