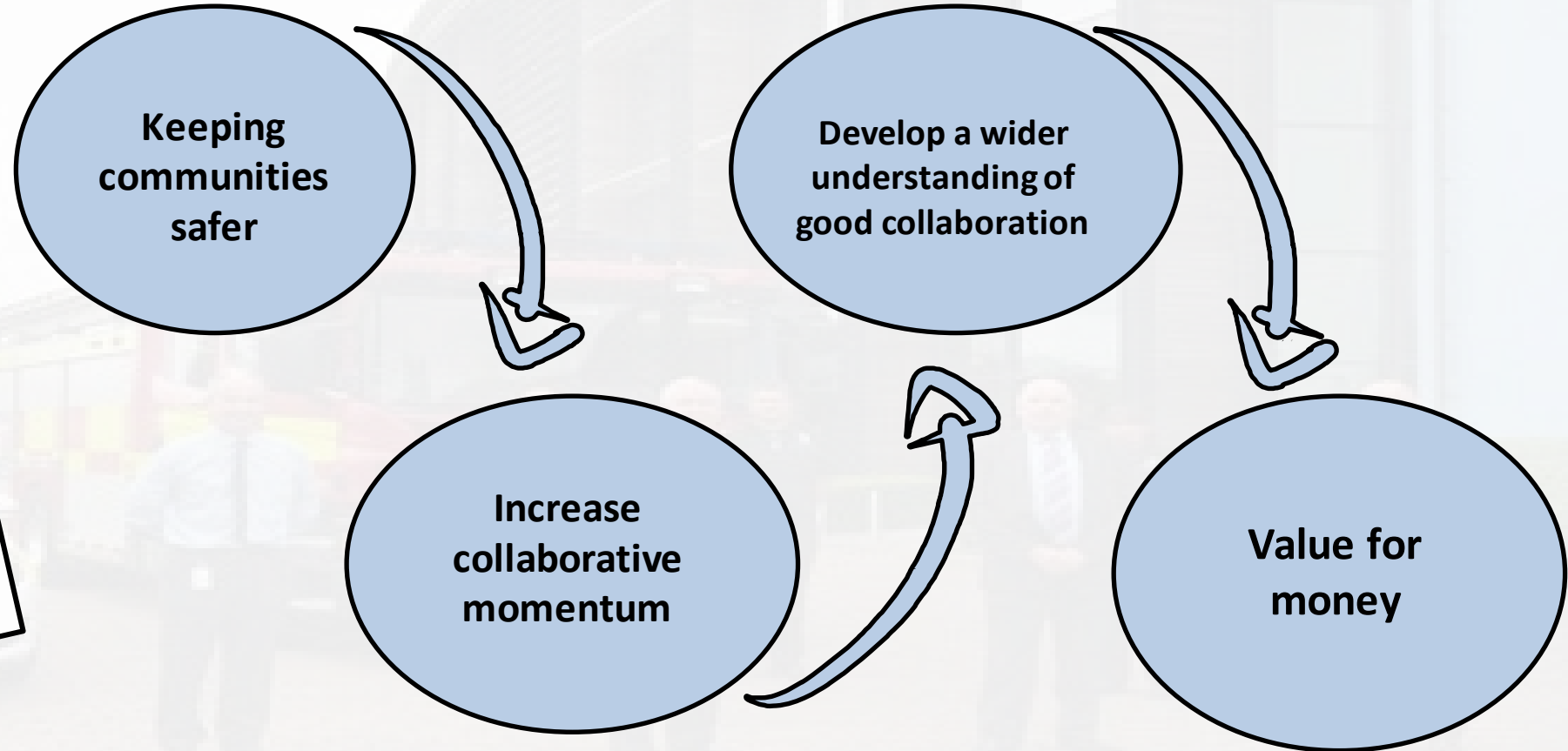
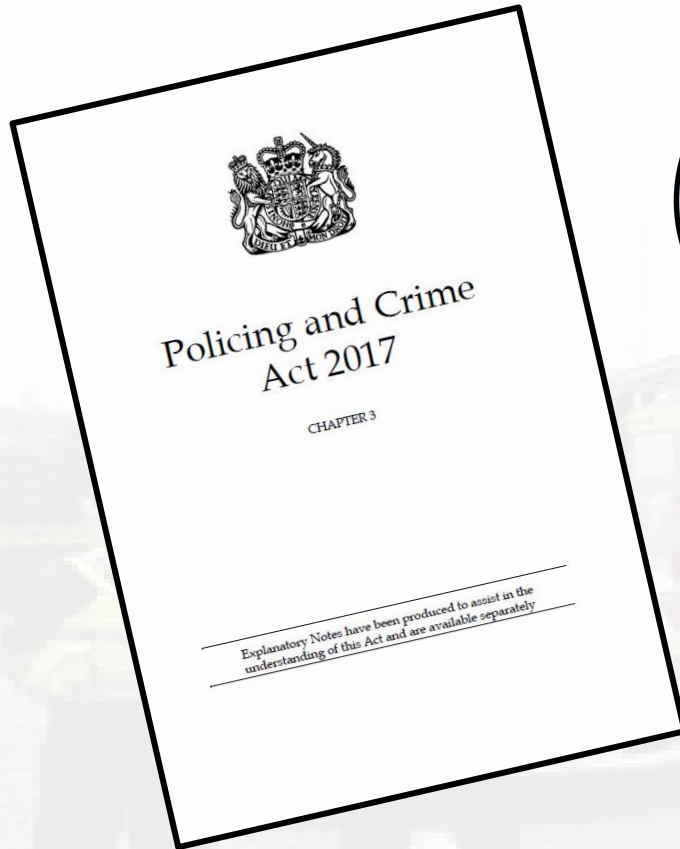

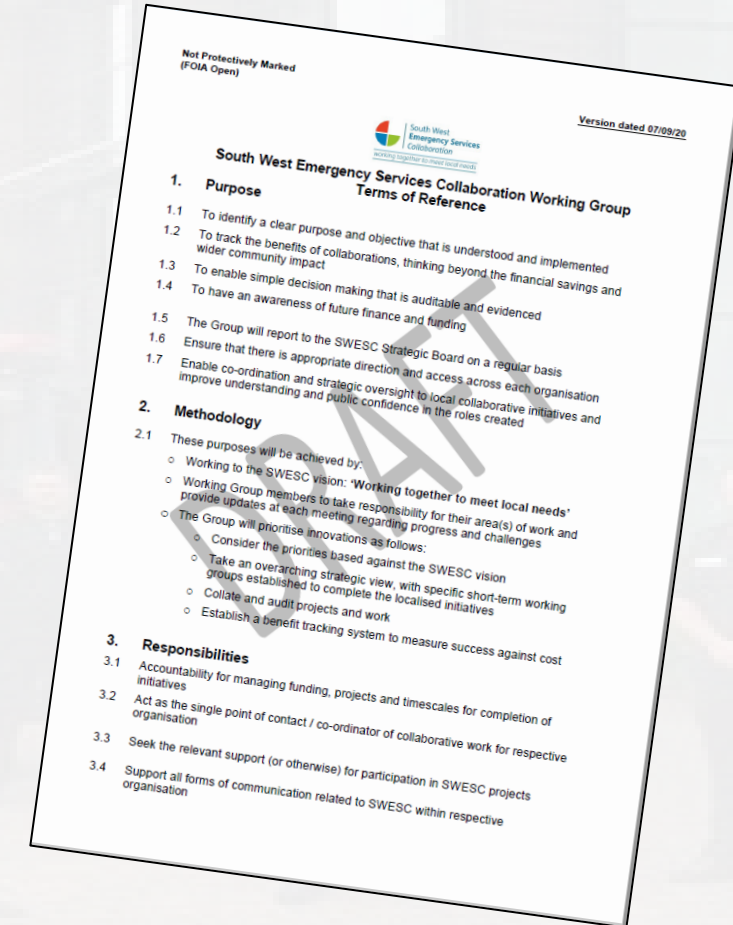

**Reports to:** Gloucestershire Constabulary, Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner (OPCC), Gloucestershire Fire and Rescue Service, Gloucestershire County Council

**Business area:** To work with partner agencies to develop a clear understanding of collaborative opportunities and how these opportunities can be implemented both strategically and operationally. The overarching strategy to improve community outcomes in line with the Police and Crime Plan for Gloucestershire and statutory requirements as set out within the Policing and Crime Act 2017.

**Description:** The GESC GG will also oversee development and understanding of information requirements to ensure the success of a shared strategy, including financial information.

**Objectives:**

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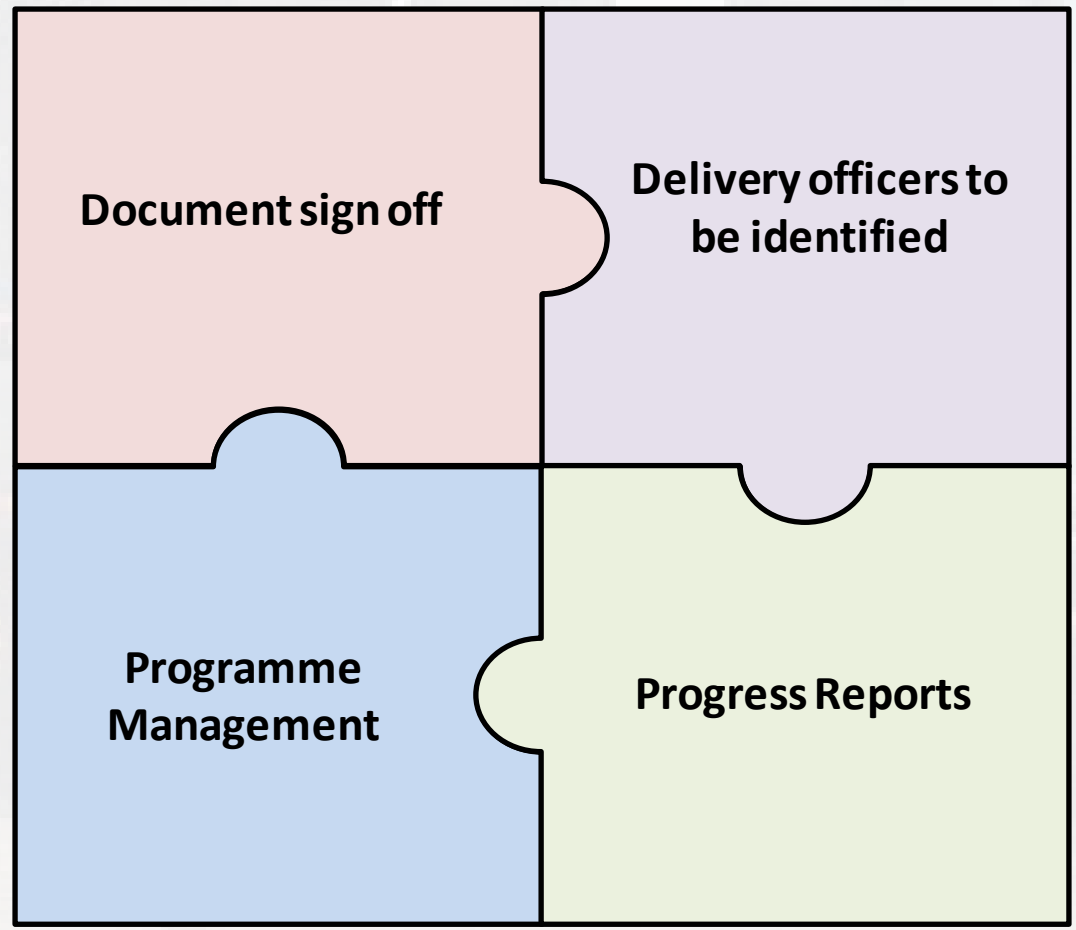
