Suicide/Mental Health Support: At the ASCC meeting on 6 September 2022, the committee proposed a joint review (ASCC and HOSC) of work to support people of all ages at risk of taking their own lives.</p> <p>2. Newton Europe Outcome Report Members requested an update from Newton Europe on the outcomes of the work undertaken in response to the LGA peer review in 2022 (to transform the Gloucestershire Health and Social Care System and provide better outcomes for its residents). Newton last reported to HOSC at a joint committee meeting (with ASCC) held on 15 November 2022. Newton Europe are due to commence a new piece of work (commissioned by GCC/NHS Gloucestershire) – members requested an update on the progress/findings of the work at the October meeting.</p> <p>3. NHS Workforce Issues – proposed by Cllr Paul Hodgkinson at the HOS meeting on 31 January 2023</p> <p>4. NHS Dentistry – At the GCC Corporate Overview and Scrutiny Committee Meeting on 19 April 2023, members received an update on Council Motion 910 (Dentistry Issues). In response to the work/actions relating specifically to the Gloucestershire Health Overview and Scrutiny Committee, the Chair of Health Scrutiny informed members that the committee had already looked into the issue in detail and proposed that the committee continue to do this. In response to the suggestion of making Gloucestershire a ‘magnet county’, members agreed to split the resolution into two parts and ask the Health Scrutiny Committee to consider a piece of work specifically looking at the recruitment issues of dental professionals. The Economic Growth Scrutiny Committee to consider a broader piece of work around employment in the county, the attraction/barriers of people moving into the county for work (‘magnet county’), to include a sectoral analysis. Once each piece of work is completed, the Chair of each respective Committee to report back to Corporate Scrutiny, at which point, if members feel further work is needed to be done, a Task and Finish Group to be considered.
